



NOTICE TO RESIDENT

Beechwood Avenue Utility Work (Charlevoix Street to Putman Avenue)

Temporary Road Closure

May 2018

Dear Resident,

Beginning in June, construction for utility work will commence on Beechwood Avenue.

WHO: AECON was retained by Enbridge to complete the gas main relocations.

WHY: The existing gas main sections are in conflict with the upcoming sewer work.

WHAT: **Two locations along Beechwood Avenue will be temporarily closed to vehicle traffic this summer** while two sections of gas main will be relocated in advance of upcoming sewer replacement work.

- **Putman Avenue will be closed at Beechwood Avenue from June 4 to 17.**
- **Beechwood Avenue will be closed from Charlevoix Street to St. Charles Street from July 16 to 29.**

WHEN: The gas main relocation at Putman Avenue is planned for June. The upcoming sewer work at the same location is planned for July to September of this year.

The gas main relocation between Springfield Road and Loyer Street is planned for June and July of this year. The up-coming sewer work at the same location is planned for the summer of 2019.

WHERE: The first gas main relocation is at the northeast corner of Beechwood Avenue and Putman Avenue. The second gas main relocation is from Springfield Road to Loyer Street.

Transportation Management

For the first gas main relocation, **Putman Avenue will be closed at Beechwood Avenue from June 4 to 17.** During that time, the sidewalk on the north side of Beechwood Avenue will be closed. The pedestrian detour will be Acacia Avenue, Chapleau Avenue and Putman Avenue. Bike lanes will be closed along Beechwood Avenue through the construction zone. Cyclists and motorists will share the road.

For the second gas main relocation, **Beechwood Avenue will be closed from Charlevoix Street to St. Charles Street from July 16 to 29.** Local access for vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained. The signed detour for the Beechwood Avenue road closure (for motorists and cyclists) will be on Charlevoix Street, Barrette Street and St. Charles Street. The signed detour to Springfield Avenue (for motorists and cyclists) will be on Mackay Street, Ivy Crescent and Putman Avenue).

The above dates may change due to weather conditions and other factors affecting construction. OC Transpo Bus Detours

During the Beechwood Avenue closure between Charlevoix Street and St. Charles Street, OC Transpo bus routes #7, #17, #19 and #6WB (Greenboro) will follow the signed detour on Charlevoix Street, Barrette Street and St. Charles Street. Bus route #6EB (Rockcliffe) will take the following detour: Mackay Street, Ivy Crescent, Putman Avenue.

Bus stops within the construction zones will be temporarily relocated.
